## **OUR ERITH ART & PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITION "OUR ERITH" 2016**

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The exhibition is organised by the Friends of Christ Church Erith in association with Bexley College.
- 2. Invitations to exhibit are open to young people aged 5-17 years and adults aged 18 years and above. Professionals will also be able to exhibit.
- The subject of the exhibition is "Our Erith" and entries should be a visual artistic interpretation of any aspect of Erith life, architecture, landscape, or people past or present.
- 4. Acceptable entries for the exhibition can either be newly created original works in the form of a photograph, painting, drawing, embroidery, model or sculpture. Other forms of visual art will be considered at the discretion of Friends of Christ Church Committee.
- 5. Unless by prior agreement with Friends of Christ Church Erith entries will be limited to one per entrant.
- 6. Entrants must complete an entry form in order for their work to be considered for display. The form will assist the exhibition organisers to log in work, to organise the exhibition and ensure entries can be collected after the exhibition.
- 7. Entrants will be asked to provide their name, gender, address and their age. In the case of entries via schools, there can be a selection process organised by schools to determine which entries will be submitted for exhibiting.
- 8. Entrants will be required to sign a declaration on their entry form agreeing to these Terms and Conditions. In the case of young people aged 5-17 years, an adult, or teacher in the case of school entries, will be required to approve the entry and agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant. The adult may be the child's parent or guardian and must provide their own contact details (not the child's) and the address at which the child lives.
- 9. Entry forms should be submitted by post to Mr Jim Bennett, Friends of Christ Church Erith, c/o 59 Hillingdon Road, Barnehurst, Kent DA7 6LN. The final date for receipt of forms is Saturday 30 April 2016.
- 10. Friends of Christ Church Erith will photograph each entry and log in to a register, assigning each entry a number. Any work that could cause offence or does not meet the brief outlined in clause 3 may be excluded from the exhibition by the Friends of Christ Church Committee. In the event that there are more works than exhibition space, Friends of Christ Church Erith will determine at their discretion which entries will go forward to be displayed in the exhibition.
- 11. It will be the responsibility of entrants to bring their entries to the collection point at Christ Church, Victoria Road, Erith DA8 3AN between the hours of 10am 8pm on Wednesday 11 May 2016 and between the hours of 10.30am 3pm on Thursday 12 May 2016.

- 12. Entries must be suitably framed or protected in such a way as they are ready for display.
- 13. Friends of Christ Church Erith retain the right to refuse to display items submitted after the deadline or where they are not suitably framed, protected or ready for display.
- 14. Exhibits that are sent through the post or delivered by courier, unless by prior agreement with Friends of Christ Church Erith, will be disqualified and will not be returned.
- 15. In order to make best use of exhibition space, the size of entries is limited to 60cmsx 85 cms. For three dimensional entries a size no greater than 45cms for each side would be preferable. Friends of Christ Church Erith will consider larger entries on their individual merit, but reserve the right not to include them in the exhibition if there is insufficient exhibition space.
- 16. The Friends of Christ Church will organise and display entries at their own discretion in an exhibition at Christ Church, Erith between Friday 13 May and Sunday 15 May 2016.
- 17. Entrants retain the copyright to their entries but grant to the Friends of Christ Church, Erith a perpetual non-exclusive royalty-free licence to publish their entry (across all media), post the entry online and on any other platforms yet to be envisaged. This licence will be deemed to include all the necessary rights and permissions to enable such use by the Friends of Christ Church, Erith to complete the administration of this exhibition and the possible production of a 2017 calendar for charity using photographs of selected exhibits.
- 18. Entrants will be able to display their work with a price for sale if they so wish. Friends of Christ Church Erith will not seek a commission but would ask those entrants, who sell their work to consider a donation to Friends of Christ Church Erith. Friends of Christ Church Erith accept no responsibility if exhibits that are sold are contrary to the declared ownership on the entry form.
- 19. Exhibits will be available for collection at the close of the exhibition (from 5pm on Sunday 15 May 2016). If items are not collected on the appointed dates, Friends of Christ Church Erith accept no responsibility for loss or damage. No feedback on any entry will be provided.
- 20. All entries must be the original work of the entrant, or a previously produced piece of art currently owned by the entrant, and must not infringe the rights of any other party.
- 21. Friends of Christ Church accepts no responsibility if entrants ignore these Terms and Conditions, and entrants agree to indemnify the Friends of Christ Church, Erith against any claim by any third party from any breach of these Terms and Conditions.
- 22. Exhibits must not contain defamatory, obscene, offensive, or any other unsuitable material.

- 23. The Friends of Christ Church's decision as to the successful entries for display and possible inclusion in a subsequent calendar is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 24. The Friends of Christ Church Erith reserves the right to disqualify any entry which breaches any of these Terms and Conditions
- 25. The Friends of Christ Church Erith reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions or cancel this exhibition at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, or if circumstances arise outside of its control.
- 26. The Friends of Christ Church Erith, and/or any other organisation associated with this exhibition cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure or malfunction or any other problem with any server, Internet access, system or otherwise which may result in any entry being lost or not properly registered or recorded.
- 27. The Friends of Christ Church Erith will not accept liability for any damage or loss to any artwork.
- 28. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
